Report Highlights:

On May 13, 2019, the People's Republic of China's Ministry of Finance (MOF), State Council Tariff Commission (SCTC) announced that supplementary import tariffs levied on certain U.S. products would be increased. The announcement includes four annexes and specifies tariff increases to 25, 20, 10, and 5 percent, affecting over 300 U.S. agricultural products valued at approximately \$3 billion in 2017. Some of these products are also subject to earlier tariff increases by China.1 This brings the total number of U.S. agricultural and related products targeted by additional Chinese tariffs since April 2018 to over 1,000 products, valued at approximately \$22.6 billion in 2017. The increased tariffs will be calculated in aggregate with earlier additional tariffs and will be effective beginning on June 1, 2019. U.S. exporters should check with their local importers to verify changes in tariff treatment.

On May 13, 2019, the People's Republic of China's Ministry of Finance (MOF), State Council Tariff Commission (SCTC) announced that supplementary import tariffs levied on certain U.S. products would be increased. This brings the total number of U.S. agricultural and related products targeted by additional Chinese tariffs since April 2018 to over 1,000 products, valued at approximately \$22.6 billion in 2017. The increased tariffs will be calculated in aggregate with earlier additional tariffs and will be effective beginning on June 1, 2019. U.S. exporters should check with their local importers to verify changes in tariff treatment.

Executive Summary:

On May 13, 2019, the People's Republic of China's Ministry of Finance (MOF), State Council Tariff Commission (SCTC) announced that supplementary import tariff rates levied on U.S. products would increase. The list of affected products in the announcement is the same list that was proposed on August 6, 2018. MOF separated China's response to the U.S. 301 Investigation into four annexes which specify tariff rates set at 25, 20, 10, and 5 percent, affecting over 300 U.S. agricultural products valued at approximately \$3 billion in 2017.

History of China's Response to U.S. 301-related Tariffs

MOF has updated its response to the U.S. 301 Investigation several times. To date, MOF has administered additional U.S. 301-related tariffs piecemeal, and at lower rates than initially proposed. Since July 2018, the implementation of the original scope of U.S. products targeted has expanded, and the applied tariff rates has increased. MOF's May 13 announcement will begin implementing the increased supplemental duties on the entire scope of products in full force on June 1, 2019. The May 13 announcement states that additional U.S. 301-related tariffs will be calculated in aggregate with earlier tariff increases.

Product Scope:

The agricultural and related products included in the May 13 announcement encompass a broad range of categories, including live animals and animal products, horticultural products, grains and oilseeds, food ingredients, prepared foods, wine and distilled spirits, and sweeteners.

General Information:

This GAIN report contains an unofficial translation of the May 13, 2019 announcement, an example of the tariff calculation methodology, and separate tariff schedules for U.S. agricultural products (Appendix 2), fisheries products (Appendix 3), and forestry products (Appendix 4) impacted by each round of additional tariffs. They include an English translation of the Mandarin product descriptions, the Most-Favored-Nation (MFN) tariff rate or Provisional tariff rate, additional tariffs in response to the U.S. 232 Investigation, and the current total tariff rates related to the U.S. 301 Investigation. The appendices do not include Value-Added Tax (VAT) rates, which are beyond the scope of this report. Note: The appendices in this report do not correspond with the Annexes of the Ministry of Finance's May 13 announcement.

Disclaimer:

This summary is based on a review of the Chinese announcement and therefore should not, under any circumstances, be viewed as a definitive reading of the regulation in question, or of its implications for U.S. agricultural export trade interests. In the event of a discrepancy or discrepancies between this summary and the complete regulation or announcement as published in Mandarin, the latter shall prevail.

UNOFFICIAL TRANSLATION OF MINISTRY OF FINANCE ANNOUNCEMENT

State Council Tariff Committee Announcement on "Increasing Tariffs on Some Products Origin in the United States" Tariff Committee Notice [2019] No. 3

On May 9, 2019, the U.S. government announced that the tariff rate imposed on the \$200 billion list of goods imported from China would be increased to 25% from 10% since May 10, 2019. The above measures by the United States have led to an escalation of Sino-US economic and trade frictions, contrary to the consensus between China and the United States on resolving trade differences through consultations, jeopardizing the interests of both sides and not meeting the general expectations of the international community.

According to the "People's Republic of China Foreign Trade Law", "People's Republic of China Import and Export Tariff Regulations" and other laws and regulations and the basic principles of international law, the State Council Tariff Committee decided that tariffs on the certain products originating in the United States will be increased since 0:00 on June 1, 2019. The relevant matters are hereby announced as follows:

- 1. To increase the tariff rate of some of the commodities in the "State Council Tariff Committee Announcement on Imposing Tariffs on US\$60 Billion of Imported Goods from the United States" (Tariff Committee Notice [2018] No. 8), and the tariff rate will be implemented in accordance with the State Council Tariff Committee Announcement on "Imposing Tariffs on Some Products Origin in the United States (Second Batch)" (Tariff Committee Notice [2018] No. 6). Namely: 2,493 tax items listed in Annex 1 shall be subject to a 25% tariff; 1078 tax items listed in Annex 2 shall be subject to a 20% tariff; and 974 tax items listed in Annex 3 shall be subject to a 10% tariff; and the 595 tax items listed in Annex 4 shall be still subject to a 5% tariff.
- 2. Other matters shall be implemented in accordance with the State Council Tariff Committee Announcement [2018] No. 6.
