Since stay-at-home orders in response to the coronavirus pandemic were implemented in most regions of North America in early March, the downturn in wood products prices has been steep and unrelenting. In framing lumber, signs that prices are reversing course are now evident, and a steady stream of mill curtailments in recent weeks is at the core of the trend change (see table). With demand imploding due to the sharp cutback in construction, producers are making a concerted effort to align supplies with expected consumption.
